- 1. Call to order and meeting recording announcement
- 2. Roll call
- 3. Notice of publication: Published in the Dunn County Newspaper April 17, 2024 and posted on the town hall window, and town website on April 10, 2024
- 4. Select chairperson for BOR
- 5. Select a Vice-Chairperson for BOR
- 6. Training requirement met: In 2024 at least one member of the BOR must attend a training session approved by the Wisconsin Department of Revenue within one year of the BOR's first meeting. Jerry Mrdutt and Jeremy Kozumplik have both met the training requirements for 2024.
- 7. Review the town has an ordinance for the confidentiality of income and expense information provided to the assessor.
- 8. Review of new laws.
- 9. Adoption of policy regarding the procedure for sworn telephone and sworn written testimony.
- 10. Adoption of policy regarding the procedure for waiver of BOR hearing requests.
- 11. Filing and summary of Annual Assessment Report by Assessor's Office.
- 12. Receipt of the assessment roll by Clerk from the Assessor.
- 13. Receive the Assessment Roll and sworn statements from the Clerk.

- 14. Review Assessment Roll and perform statutory duties:
 - a. Examine the roll
 - b. Correct description or calculation errors
 - c. Add omitted property
 - d. Eliminate double assessed property
- 15. Discussion/Action-Certify all corrections of error under State Law (Sec.70.43, WI Stats.)
- 16. Discussion/Action-Verify with the Assessor that open book changes are included in the assessment roll
- 17. Allow taxpayers to examine assessment data
- 18. During the first two hours, consideration of:
 - a. Waivers of the required 48-hour notice of intent to file an objection when there is good cause
 - b. Requests for waiver of the BOR hearing allowing the property owner an appeal directly to the circuit court
 - c. Requests to testify by telephone or submit sworn written statement
 - d. Subpoena requests
 - e. Act on any other legally allowed/required BOR matters
- 19. Review Notices of Intent to File Objection
- 20. Proceed to hear objections from land owners-taxpayers, if any and if proper notice/waivers given unless scheduled for another date.
- 21. Consider/act on scheduling additional BOR date
- 22. Adjournment
