**Resolution Authorizing Tainter Lake Rehabilitation District Authority to Enact and Enforce Slow No Wake Ordinance**

**Whereas**, Section 30.77(3)(am)(1)(a) of Wisconsin Statutes authorizes the Town to adopt a resolution authorizing the Lake District to enact and enforce ordinances; and

**Whereas**, the Tainter Lake Rehabilitation District was formed in 2022; and

**Whereas**, the Town of Tainter repealed Ordinance 123.10, Joint Slow No Wake Ordinance at the February 13, 2025 regular town board meeting; and

**Whereas**, the Tainter Lake Rehabilitation District plans to enact and adopt Slow No Wake Ordinance.

**Now, Therefore**, at the regular town meeting of the Town of Tainter, Dunn County, Wisconsin, by roll call vote of the Town Board Supervisors on this 13<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2025 duly assembled and voting resolves and orders as follows:

**Be It Resolved**, the Town Board of the Town of Tainter, Dunn County, Wisconsin hereby adopts Resolution 2025-01 authorizing Tainter Lake Rehabilitation District authority to enact and enforce slow no wake ordinance.
